1. Ann Braddock said that 13 people had signed up for Judy Warren's workshop on fabric postcards.
2. The minutes for the February meeting were passed out by Diane Eardley and approved by the board.
3. Betty Kelley has been picking up the mail.
4. Membership rosters will be available next month. Kristin Otte had problems in preparing the roster because of a computer virus.
5. Sue Scholl said 4 old books have been returned to the library.
6. Lynn Laughrin suggested that the newsletter be printed on white paper to save money, and the board agreed.
7. Nola Ferguson said that refreshments have been going smoothly.
8. Cathy Rampton said there has been very good turn out for block of the month.
9. Judy Gorrindo mentioned that the Camarillo Guild has been told by the District Attorney's Office in Ventura that it is illegal for them to sell tickets for their Opportunity Quilt which has been designed by Ellen Heck.
10. Maggie said that Carol Boyce has been asked to make a banner for the Quilters' Hall of Fame, and she is considering the request.
11. Diane Eardley showed her foundation-pieced name tag which was embroidered by Carol Meyer on the Bernina 1630 at Grant House. She will write a brief article for the April newsletter encouraging guild members to make their own name tag out of fabric. She pointed out that the March *Quilters Newsletter Magazine* has designs for several foundation-pieced album blocks which are appropriate for name tags.
12. Cathy Rampton presented a request from Cynthia Bonner to sell her hand-dyed fabrics before the guild meetings. The board members expressed some concerns, and Maggie will check the incorporation papers to see if there is anything in them which would prevent a member from selling items at the meeting.
13. Diane Eardley is making arrangements with Sarah House, an AIDS hospice, to receive quilts this year as part of the guild's Community Quilt Project. A call for fabric and quilt block donations will be made in the next newsletter and at the next meeting. Claire Hemke will be called to determine the status of the guild's fabric stash for this project.
