3. Opportunity Quilt - 'Sunflower' blocks donated by Jane Manasse will be used to start project; Judy Gorrindo volunteered to chair in December. Judy and Maggie will coordinate quilt top design; there are enough blocks for two quilts. Block histories should be obtained.
4. August meeting - Members were asked to show up at 6:00 PM if possible to help setup. A notice will be placed on door at Samarkand to direct members to Oak Park.
5. Santa Barbara quilt - The quilt was photographed for Fiesta, the photograph should appear in the Santa Barbara Newspress.
6. Workshops - Noelle Olson workshop is filled.
7. Treasurer - Carol Fay reported fund stable.
8. Membership - money is still being received from new members.
9. Challenge - Jan Inouye discussed how challenge quilts will be judged and displayed.
10. Library - Progress being made with prompt return of books. Still a few books not being returned on time, one possibly missing. Discussed rearranging library position to handle book checkout more effectively.
11. Block of Month - Guild members voted not to compile pattern booklet.
12. New business - California Heritage Quilt Project asking for donations. Voted to donate \$200 if tax status of Project is investigated and approved.
