- Marty and Marily Martin helping tonight. Marty promised at a prior meeting that if you made a lot of blocks, or every block, you will receive a prize and she brought prizes to hand out: charm packs and a stack of fat quarters to the first-place winner for the year.
  - 50 quilters participated in Block of the Month, making 477 blocks during the year. There were also 12 different block winners, one each month and no repeat winners during the year.
  - Made block every month (received charm packs): Linda Bird (and every month since she joined the guild); Rita Harden; Edalee Keen; Betty Kelly; Barbara MacCallum.
  - All made 12 blocks + lots more. 4<sup>th</sup> place: Naomi Hicks made 30 blocks and all 12-last year; 3<sup>rd</sup> place Diana Hamilton made 31 blocks; 2<sup>nd</sup> place Marilyn Martin with 33 blocks and all 12 blocks last year; and first place winner with 66 blocks last year Dee Johnson (Dee received fat quarter bundle).
- Tonight 30 Roman Square blocks in Americana theme; winner is Pam Holst
- August block is “4-in-9” use floral in large squares & in the 4-patch a light green and white.
