- Sew days each Wednesday this month, Goleta Community Center, Room 2. You can turn in your challenge quilts then or call & arrange
- Next month is of course the Challenge show; bring family & friends, they are free, nice & we are all anxious to see all the quilts.

**Quilt Show: Irellie Beatie**

- 1- month in, and it is looking a little scary, not enough people volunteering to help.
- Lot of unfilled chair positions
- Committee meeting just now asked the group... why do we have a Q how?
  - All good responses – fundraising, community visibility, members show beautiful quilts they have made, vendors come & we all do a little shopping. All good responses plus the education piece nice, boutique is nice, though to Irellie, the big reason we have quilt show is to celebrate the work that goes into the quilts made and to show off what has been accomplished.
  - Last show approximately 250 quilts hanging. Now, there are only 10 people on our show committee and we cannot work with that few people. Think about what you would like to do to help; know we all have lots going on in our lives; but think about what you can do. Most of the work for many committees takes place in Aug/Sept and many committee positions don't all take a lot of time. Some take more time, but not all and I need help.
  - Need a co-chair willing to take it on as chair in 2020; if you have good committee people its not that hard, all you have to do is delegate & keep people on track.
  - Need someone to head up the boutique – lot of people interested in helping, though need a lead.
  - Need someone to head up community quilts section – again, lot of people to help though need a lead.
  - Education is a big one and education booth is a big draw; kids love it, everybody likes to try things. You can come up with something completely different; being interactive is good.
    - Ranell Hansen & Susan Katz offered to head up Education.
  - Changes with how we collect data, so need acquisition chair; this person will not be responsible for all the data entry, but for collecting.
