## Cutting

## White or white on white print:

Cut 4 (4-1/2") squares.
Cut $1\left(5-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}\right)$ square and cut diagonally in both directions to make 4 triangles.
Green:
Cut 1 (4-1/2") square.
Cut $1\left(5-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}\right)$ square and cut diagonally in both directions to make 4 triangles.
Purple:
Cut $2\left(4-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}\right)$ squares and cut diagonally once to make 4 triangles.

## Assembly

1. Arrange triangles to form a block unit. Piece as shown below. Make 4 block units.


Press to green. Press to purple.
2. Arrange triangle units and squares. Sew into rows. Press seams to squares. Sew rows together. Press seams to outside. Block should measure 12-1/2".
