

## Cutting

White print with small black motif.
Two 5-1/4" squares.

## Black

Five 4-1/2" squares.

## Red

Two 5-1/4" squares.

## Assembly

1. Draw a line corner to corner on the two white squares. This is the cutting line.

Draw a line $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from the cutting line and on each side of the cutting line. These are the sewing lines.

2. Pin white squares and red squares right sides together. Stitch on the two sewing lines. Cut on the cutting line. Press seam to the red. Trim units to $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

3. Arrange the triangle units with the black squares to make the Contrary Wife block. Sew into rows. Press to black squares. Sew rows together. Block should measure 12-1/2".
