

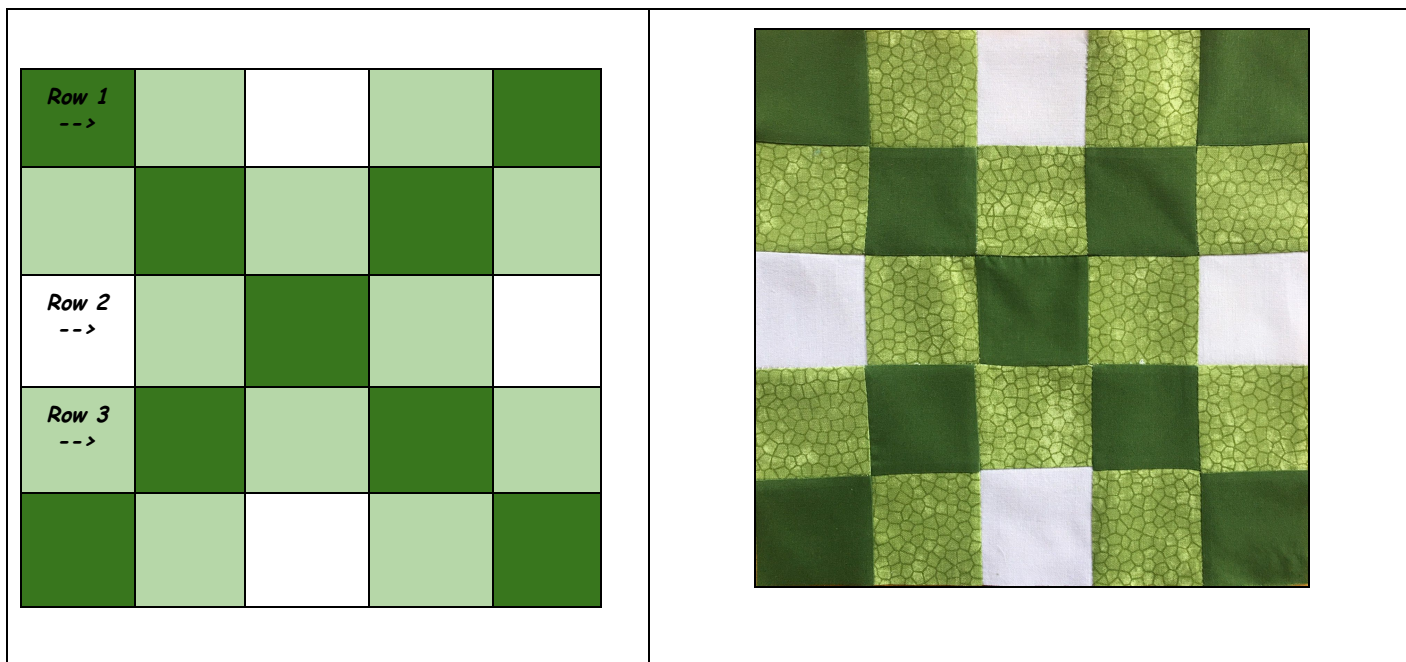
# IRISH CHAIN BLOCK

## Fabric and Cutting

### White Fabric:

Cut 1 - 2 ½" x 10" strip

### Deep Green Solid/Small Print

Cut 1 - 2 ½" x 22 ½" strip

### Light Green Solid/Small Print

Cut 1 - 2 ½" x 10" strip  
Cut 1 - 2 ½" x 20" strip

## Assembly

- Sew the White 2 ½" x 10" strip to the Light Green 2 ½" x 10" strip. Press the seam toward the green fabric and cut the strip into four 2 ½" pieces.
- Cut one 2 ½" square from the Dark Green 2 ½" x 22 ½" strip.
- Sew the remainder of the Dark Green strip to the Light Green 2 ½" x 20" strip. Press toward the Dark Green fabric and cut the strip into eight 2 ½" pieces.
- Assemble the block in the following three rows, referring the the pictured block for piece orientation.
- Row #1 Two Dark Green & Light Green pieces, one Light Green & White piece then two Dark Green and Light Green pieces.
- Row #2 One White & Light Green piece, the (1) Dark Green square then one Light Green and White piece.
- Row #3 This row is a repeat of row #1, reversing the middle piece orientation.
