
JACOB'S LADDER 12" Finished block

July 2018 Coastal Quilters Guild Block of the Month





Cutting *Use patriotic prints if you have them.*

Light: Off white or light beige/tan 1 strip 2-1/2" wide x 30". Two 5-1/4" squares. Red: Two 5-1/4" squares. Dark Blue: 1 strip 2-1/2" wide x 30".


Assembly

1. Draw a line corner to corner on the two light squares. This is the cutting line.


Draw a line 1/4" from the cutting line and on each side of the cutting line. These are the sewing lines. Pin light squares and red squares right sides together. Stitch on the two sewing lines. Cut on the cutting line. Press seams to the red. Trim units to 4-1/2".





2. Sew the light strip to the blue strip. Press seam to blue. Sewn strips should measure 4-1/2" across. Cut into 2-1/2" units. Sew units together to make 4 patch units. 4 patch units should measure 4-1/2".



 Arrange triangle and 4 patch units to make the Jacob's Ladder block. Sew units into rows. Press seams to 4-patch units. Sew rows together. Press seams to outside rows. Block should measure 12-1/2".
