

## **Quilters Workshop** - Charity Quilts

Create beautiful quilts and quilted items while reviewing and perfecting basic quilting techniques of cutting, piecing, setting, basting, quilting and binding. ## **Quilting and Patchwork -** *Emphasis on Art Quilts: Portraits and Landscapes*

Students will learn through demonstration and hands-on use of tools and equipment provided. Principles of shape, color, texture, value and line will be discussed.

## Patchwork and Quilting: Rotary Magic

Master the key techniques of the rotary cutter, one of the most valuable tools of today's quiltmaker! In addition, learn many basic quiltmaking skills while machine piecing four lap size, quick and easy quilts, including Rail Fence, Irish Chain, Lover's Knot and Around the Twist. The class will also include valuable tips and tricks on hand and machine quilting. This term the class will feature the Hidden Wells Pattern.

#### Patchwork and Quilting: String Quilts

String quilts are scrap quilts that consist of narrow strips of fabric sewn to a foundation. Historically, scraps from home sewn dresses, shirts and aprons were pieced to foundations of cloth, newspaper or catalog pages. Join us, as we string together squares, triangles and diamonds into a contemporary quilt that mimics the beauty of these antique favorites.
