Discharge Dyeing by Mary Tabar

Come to this fun class! We will learn different methods of discharge dyeing, by using stamps, stencils, brushes and found objects. Discharge dyeing is removing color from fabric using different types of bleach.

Supply list to join the fun:

- Old clothes, even shoes get bleach dripped upon!
- 100% Cotton or Rayon Fabric or shirts (spandex is fine) to discharge dye. Shirts
 and fabric for discharge dyeing need to be dark colors. 3 yds. is a good start!

 Try bleaching a small corner before coming, if you are not sure.
- Any stamps, stencils and brushes you would like to experiment with. (I also have lots!)
- If you are sensitive to bleach odors, please bring your own facial masks, respirator.
- \$5 supply fee for the bleaches
