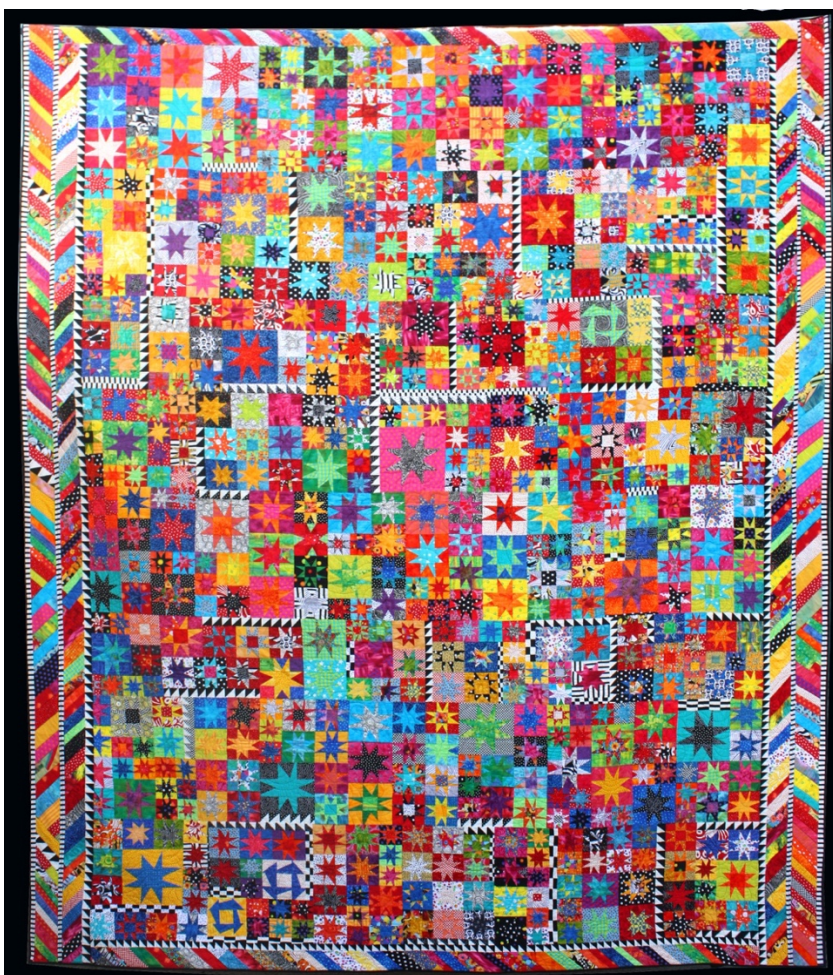
Improvitational Design and Technique Class

Twinkle is both easy to make it and to make it modern with your fabric choices and color blocking. The block is a liberated star. I fell in love with it when I made my super-sized star quilt. No two blocks are alike... different sizes, colors, fabrics, dimensions! This makes it so personal and unique.

Create a Liberated Eight Point Star quilt using a variation of the nine-patch block. Learn how to place different size blocks together into one big, beautiful quilt. In this class you will learn about improv sewing, designing blocks with personality, while keeping your work squared and accurate.

Supply List:



- Sewing Machine in good working order
- Basic sewing supplies including scissors, rotary supplies and 20"+ ruler
- Personal Cutting Mat
- New Rotary blade in your Rotary Cutter
- Neutral cotton thread 50W preferred
- Small Square Ruler (6-1/2")
- In class you will have time to make about a dozen stars. Bring an assortment of “your color story” that may include fat quarters and scraps and if you like the top quilt, bring some “white” yardage to help your design. If you like the bottom, bring all your bright, true colors, or if you have another idea – bring what makes you happy!
