Bee Saunders designed this block that reminds us of a foursquare playground game. Enjoy recess time while you sew this block of the month.


## FABRICS

Background: Kona ash grey background - provided at April meeting
Squares: Small-scale prints or solids in pairs of red, yellow, black, and white. Use four different fabrics in the block.

## CUTTING



## A, B, C, D-Red, Yellow, Black and White

From each fabric, cut:
$2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square (2)
$1^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}(1)$
$2^{\prime \prime}-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}(1)$
$1^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}(1)$

## CONSTRUCTION

Use 1/4" seam allowances. Press seams open to make
block lie flat.

1. Follow piecing diagram.
2. Trim the block to $12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, being sure the square is centered at the $6-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ mark .
