


Churn Dash
12" Block

Block of the Month



May is a time for planting in the garden, putting up jams and jellies and just enjoying the outdoors. Stitch up this Churn Dash in prints of sunshine and blue skies.

Cutting

White or white on white print:

Cut one 4-1/2" square.

Cut two 5-1/4" squares.

Cut 4 (2-1/2" x 4-1/2") rectangles.

Yellow:

Cut 4 (2-1/2" x 4-1/2") rectangles.

Medium Blue:

Cut two 5-1/4" squares.

Assembly

1. Draw a line corner to corner on the two 5-1/4" white squares. This is the cutting line.


Draw a line 1/4" from the cutting line and on each side of the cutting line. These are the sewing lines.



2. Pin white squares and 5-1/4" blue squares right sides together. Stitch on the two sewing lines.

Cut on the cutting line. Press seam to the dark. Trim units to 4-1/2".

Use a Bloc Loc ruler if you have one.




3. Sew the white rectangles to a yellow rectangles. Press seam toward the yellow.



4. Arrange the triangle units, the rectangle units and the white square to make the Churn Dash block.

Sew into rows. Press seams toward rectangles. Sew rows together. Block should measure 12-1/2".
