



Coastal Quilters Guild Block of the Month

This simple yet sweet block is a Valentine for the Guild. It is my interpretation of the February 2013 block created by the "Knotty Threads" ~ Kika Hutchings and Diana Hamilton. May your heart be full of joy as you sew!



Fabric and Cutting

White Fabric:

Cut 4 - 3" x 3"

Cut 1 - 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Deep Red Solid

Cut 2 - 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Cut 1 - 2" x 26" strip

Cut 1 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Red Print

Cut 1 - 2" x 20" strip

Assembly

- Starting with the red rectangles, place a small white square on two corners.
- Sew diagonally across the square, do not trim, press toward the corner (Make 2)
- Starting with the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Red square, piece Log Cabin Style beginning with the Red Print strip, trimming even and pressing away from the center.
- Alternating Red and Red Print, continue until four rounds of fabric are added. Unit should measure 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square
- Sew this unit to the other units as shown to make a 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (unfinished) block.
