

## Tam's Patch

Finished quilt size: 42" x 52"

Finished block size: 10"

Finished border width: 1" and 5"

Fabrics needed:

Blocks:

1 yard of large children's print for blocks.


1 yard of light coordinating print for blocks.

1 yard of medium coordinating print for blocks and inner borders.

1-3/4 yards for outer borders.

2 yards (with some piecing) for backing.

1/2 yard for binding.



# Tam's Patch Instructions

## Cutting:

### Block squares:

#### Large print:

Fussy cut 24 squares 5-1/2" .

*Squares may also be randomly cut.*

*Cut the following strips along the lengthwise grain.*

#### Light coordinating print:

Cut 7 strips 3" x 1 yard.

#### Medium coordinating print:

Cut 3 strips 3" x 1 yard..

Cut 6 strips 1-1/2" x 1 yard for inner borders. Piece to make 4 borders strips.

#### Outer borders.

*Cut the following strips along the lengthwise grain.*


Cut 4 borders 5-1/2" x 1-3/4 yds.

## Assembly:


1. Sew a light 3" strip to a medium 3" strip. Make 2-1/2 strip sets. Press to the medium.

Cut into 3" x 5-1/2" units. Make 24 units.

2. Sew units to a light strip. Cut units apart. Trim to 5-1/2" square. Make 24 units.



3. Referring to the block diagram, arrange units with 5-1/2" squares. Piece block.



4. Referring to the quilt diagram, arrange blocks to form the quilt.

Sew blocks into row. Press seams in alternating directions.

Sew rows together. Press seams in alternating directions.

5. Add inner borders. Add outer borders.
