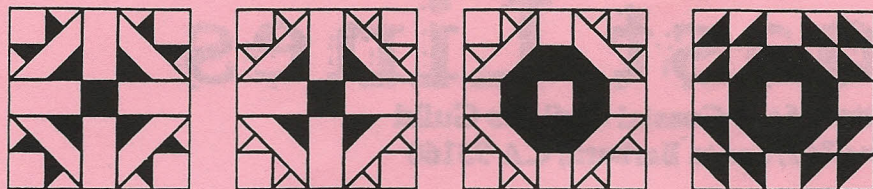



Sponsorship of the printing of the program is now the most immediate project. Several options are being discussed and will be presented at the meeting including members purchasing quarter page ads for \$50.

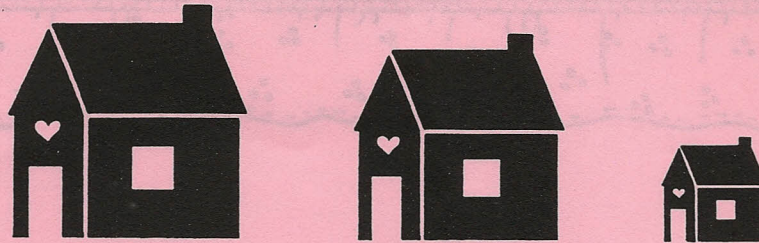
The Museum quilt will be formally presented to the Museum at its annual meeting luncheon on March 19.
