FLOWERS IN A POT

from *The Standard Book of Quilt Making*
by Marguerite Ickis

Cut: one 15" square of bleached muslin

**NOTE: PATTERNS DO NOT HAVE SEAM
ALLOWANCE INCLUDED**

Cut: three blossoms, a print of your choice
three centers (yellow?)

two green leaves, #5

one green leaf, #3, and one reversed

15" of green bias for the stems

one pot, a color of your choice

Sewing instructions:

Baste under the edges on all of the pieces.

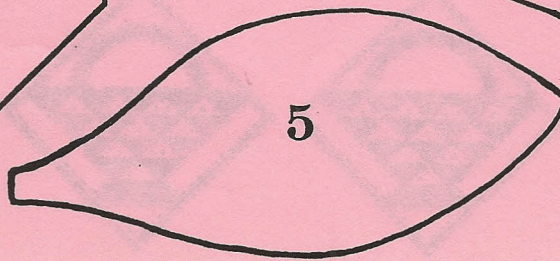
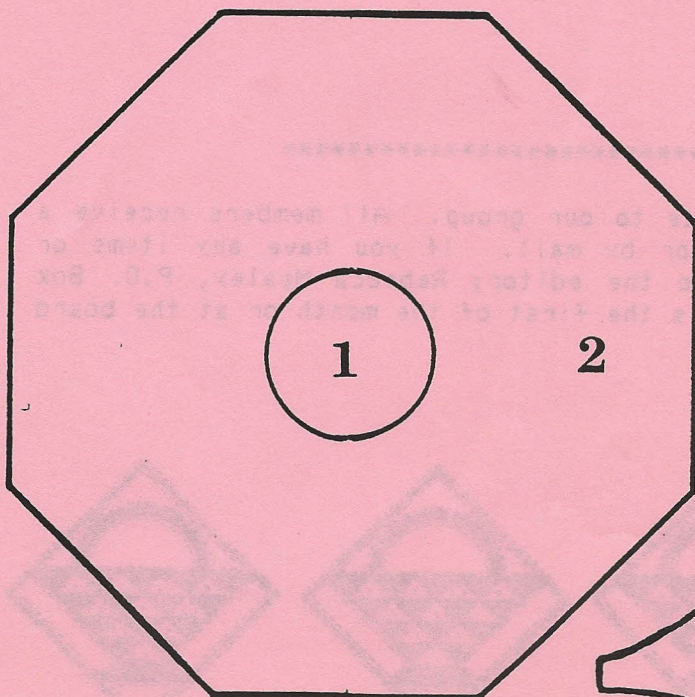
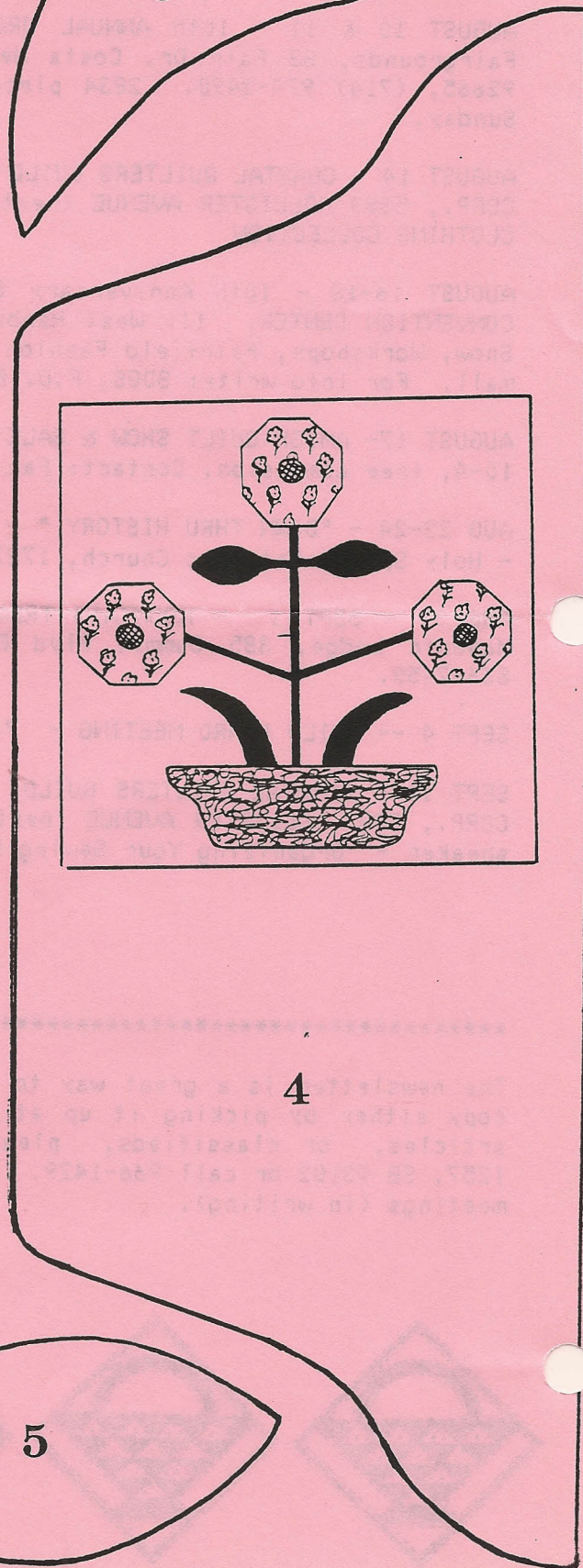
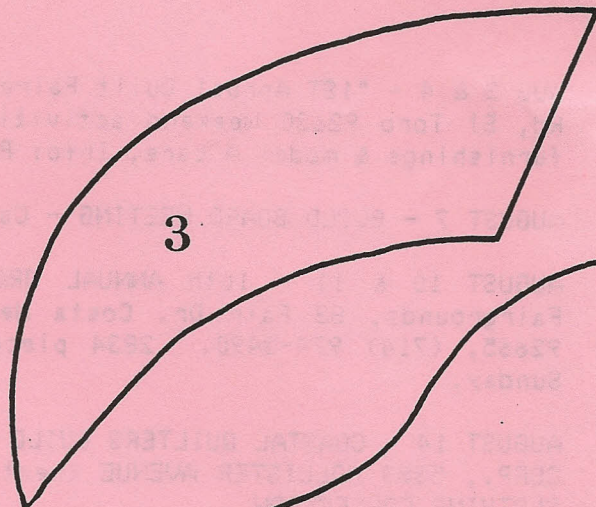
Applique the centers to the blossoms.

Position each of the blossoms and the pot

1-1/2" from the cut edges of the muslin
and mark.

Then position leaves and stems.

Applique leaves, then stems, then blossoms,
and finally the pot.



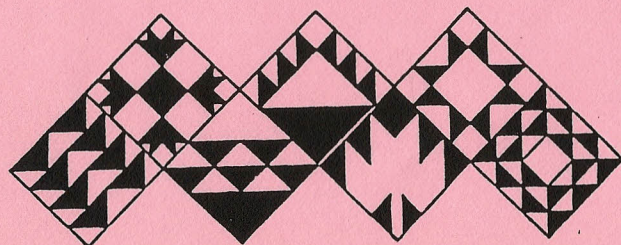
