## April Meeting Program



### Shelley Swanland

April 9

### "Cathedral Windows and So Much More"

Our April 2015 speaker, Shelley Swanland, is a popular speaker and teacher with a number of guilds. She has long been fascinated with the "Cathedral Window" technique. She reports that she always wanted to do the Cathedral Window technique, and she collected many books on the subject. However, when she discovered that this technique has historically been an intensive hand-quilting technique she was discouraged. Then Shelley developed her own method of machine stitching this technique, and she hit a home run! She has published books and appeared on media events demonstrating her unique technique. Shelley will be presenting a trunk show of her various quilts during the meeting. In the workshop, she will teach participants how to machine stitch the Cathedral Window pattern.



### Workshop: Friday, April 10

### Cathedral Window Sampler

Learn to make a Cathedral Window quilt completely by machine using three-dimensional piecing. First learn the basic elements, squares, triangles, an X block and an O block. Then put it all together in the Cathedral Window section. Quilting will be thoroughly explained. Kits will be available for purchase (optional). Pattern required - \$5 for workshop participants.

**Door Prize News:** Something new for a door prize. During the April meeting we will present a quilt made by our Sewphistocats group instead of the usual baskets.

This is a lovely springtime quilt made by all the members of the satellite group and beautifully quilted by Marty Frolli. Perhaps you saw it at this year's quilt show. **Chances will be the usual \$1.00 each or 6 for \$5.00.**



# FOUR SQUARE

May 2015 | Block of the Month  
Coastal Quilters Guild

Bee Saunders designed this block that reminds us of a four-square playground game. Enjoy recess time while you sew this block of the month.



## FABRICS

**Background:** Kona ash grey background - provided at April meeting

**Squares:** Small-scale prints or solids in pairs of **red, yellow, black, and white.** Use four different fabrics in the block.

## CUTTING

**Grey fabric** - from the provided rectangle, cut **length-wise** strips:

Cut 3 strips 1-1/2" x 12-1/2"

Cut 6 strips 1-1/2" x 5"

**A, B, C, D - Red, Yellow, Black and White**


**From each fabric, cut:**

2-1/2" x 2-1/2" square (2)

1" x 2-1/2" (1)

2"-1/2" x 5" (1)

1" x 5" (1)



## CONSTRUCTION

Use 1/4" seam allowances. Press seams open to make block lie flat.

1. Follow piecing diagram.
2. Trim the block to 12-1/2" x 12-1/2", being sure the square is centered at the 6-1/4" mark .
