## September Speaker: Norah McMeeking

September's speaker is our own Norah McMeeking, former Adult Ed teacher and author of 2 popular quilt design books. The title of her presentation is "My Great British (Quilting) Adventure," which launched her career as a statewide quilting speaker.



In 1995, Norah gave up her Adult Ed position to spend a year living and working in England while her husband was on sabbatical in Cambridge. She joined the local quilt group, volunteered at national shows, took classes from stars of the British quilting world, taught classes, and visited museums and textile collections. Upon returning home, she put together a slide presentation for guild members and then began speaking to guilds around the state, adding a workshop of hand-stitched pincushions. Ten years later, Norah authored *Bella Bella Quilts*, a book based on Italian inlaid floors, and then began teaching nationally and internationally.



Many of you know Norah, as she was our guild's newsletter editor, program chair, president and co-chair of two juried shows. She also taught Adult Education classes from 1991 - 2006. ## HOC Quilt Drop Off/Pick Up Info

Is your show quilt show-ready? Details about preparing your quilt for drop-off are found in the Quilt Entry Guidelines on the website [here](#). Show quilts must have a label and hanging sleeve (attached so the quilt is no more than 80" long from the top of the sleeve). And, they must be delivered to a quilt collector in a pillowcase or box, labeled as directed in the Guidelines.

All show quilts must be delivered to a quilt collector by September 1st. A quilt collector will contact each member with a quilt in the show to arrange for quilt delivery to her. The collector will measure each quilt and check for the required quilt label, sleeve, and labeled pillowcase or box. Liability and receipt forms will be completed.

On Sunday, September 16th, quilts must be picked up at Earl Warren Showgrounds between 6-7 pm. To pick up a quilt, you must show the receipt provided by the quilt collector when the quilt was dropped off. If you can't pick up your quilt, you must arrange for another person to present the receipt and pick it up.

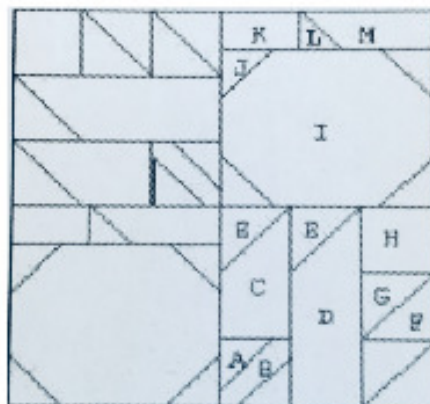
In August—for the second month in a row—Linda Bird was our Block of the Month Winner. She won Courthouse Steps blocks stitched in browns and beiges.

**PUMPKIN PATCH**

12" Block (12.5" Unfinished)

**October 2018**

Coastal Quilters Guild Block of the Month

October is the time for pumpkins! This Oct 2009 block was the fourth installment in the "Quilted Calendar" theme created by Naomi Hicks and Debbie Breyman.

Use a variety of oranges and greens if you'd like. These pumpkins 'grow' together easily so bring one to the Guild and make a spare for yourself!

**Fabric**

Green: (2) 2 ½" squares (B)  
 (2) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles (C)  
 (2) 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles (D)  
 (4) 2 ½" squares (G)  
 (2) 1 ½" squares (L)

Neutral: (12) 2" squares (A & J)  
 (6) 2 ½" squares (E & H)  
 (4) 2 ½" squares (F)  
 (2) 1 ½" x 2 ¾" rectangles (K)  
 (2) 1 ½" x 4 ¼" rectangles (M)

Orange: (2) 5 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles (I)

**ASSEMBLY****LEAF BLOCK** (make two)

**Leaf Stem Unit:** Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a neutral (A) square. Place on upper left corner of a green (B) square, right sides together and stitch on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" away from the stitching line, press. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of another neutral (A) square. Place in lower right corner of the green (B) square. Trim ¼" away from stitching line, press. Repeat to make second stem unit. Trim to 2 ½" square if needed.

Create the (C-E), (D-E) units by drawing diagonal lines on the wrong side of two neutral (E) squares. Place one (E) square on each (C) and (D) rectangle, right sides together, stitch on diagonal line - be sure to check that placement of diagonal line is the same on both rectangles. Trim ¼" from stitching line, press.

Create the (F-G) half square triangle ("HST") units by drawing a diagonal line on the wrong side of the (F) squares. With (F-G) squares right sides together, stitch ¼" from diagonal line. Cut ¼" from seam and press open. Make 4 units.

With remaining H squares, complete the leaf block as shown. Leaf Blocks should measure 6 ½" square.

**PUMPKIN BLOCK** (make two) Make the pumpkin units by drawing diagonal lines on the wrong side of the (J) squares. Position (J) squares on each corner of the orange (I) rectangle, right sides together and stitch on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" away from stitching line, press.

Make the pumpkin stem unit by drawing a diagonal line on the wrong side of the (L) square. Place (L) square on the (M) rectangle, stitch on diagonal line. Trim ¼" away from stitching line, press. Sew the (K) rectangle to the stem side of the (L-M) unit. Sew the stem unit to pumpkin unit as indicated. Pumpkin Blocks should measure 6 ½" square.

Complete the entire block as shown. Unfinished block should measure 12 ½" square.
