Students can choose from the projects which are in the book Thoroughly Modern Dresden or from one of my Dresden Patterns. Of course in class we will not get the entire top done. Please be aware of the skill level of each project which is noted in the book and choose according to your capabilities.

Supply List

Please choose the project you would like to make and refer to the book for the fabric requirements and supplies needed for that project. (A great beginner project would be the two quilts pictured on this handout.)

Other supplies needed are:

- Thread for piecing
- Sewing machine in good working order- Please knows how to use your machine.
- ¼" foot is helpful in establishing an accurate ¼" seam
- Rotary Cutting tools, Cutter, board and rulers
- Fabric Basting glue such as Roxann's glue
- Fabric marking tool- Blue marker, or chalk-o-liner (One that will show up on your fabric)
- Fast-2-cut Dresden Ruler or Template plastic
- Freezer Paper
- Finger Pressing tools
- Spray Starch, small plastic container, paint brush
- Basic sewing supplies –Scissors, seam ripper, straight pins, pin cushion etc.
- Scissors for Fabric, Paper and Plastic
- Mechanical Pencil

Work to do ahead of class- I assume most students are knowledgeable in how to rotary cut. **Students should have the quilt cut out so we can begin sewing in class.** Refer to the cutting chart for the project you have chosen and **cut the background squares in the size your project requires. The strips for the blades should be cut out; we will sub-cut the blades in class** as I will demonstrate cutting accurately with the fast2cut Dresden ruler or template. The center circles will be cut in class. Students can cut borders if they desire.



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
