

MAKING FACES

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- 9x12 background fabric - should read as a solid
- two contrasting 6x8 fabrics for the face
- one 3x5 light for the neck.
- smaller chunks of various colors, prints and textures for the eyes, eyelids, nose, mouth and lips
- a large print novelty fabric- fat quarter or larger; you will be cutting motifs from it to attach to the face to create character
- one yard WonderUnder or other fusible
- buttons, charms, beads or other fun stuff

Kit fee \$10

The kit contains multiple patterns for head shapes as well as eyes, nose, etc. You will also have access to a variety of novelty fabrics, sheers, metallics, buttons, trims, yarns and other items so that you can personalize your face.

While most of this project is fusible please bring your sewing machine along with a neutral thread so that you can do a bit of machine appliqué and some couching.
