## **Painting With Inks with Patt Blair**

This class is perfect for those who don't draw, don't paint, but wish they could. Bring an enlarged photo tracing from one of your own photos or choose from one of my ready to go drawings. To create your own drawing, go to pattsart.com and click on EZ Drawing button.

You'll paint using TSUKINEKO Fabric Inks and special stick applicators.

## **Supply List**

- Pencil and notebook for taking notes
- An ultra fine Sharpie marker to write on ink bottles/pens
- No less than 1/2 yard PFD (Prepared for Dying) white fabric \* (you can wash and iron plain white fabric if necessary or I will have available in class). I like a smooth surface, high thread count type fabric that feels like percale... e.g. Hoffman's PFD pattern # 1377. I'll have some for sale with me.
- Approx, a fat quarter of white or off-white scrap fabric for practice.
- Fabric scissors
- Masking or painter's tape
- 1 smooth large white plastic trash bag (like for tall kitchen cans)
- A white plastic picnic plate to mix on should you wish to mix inks (totally optional)
- Selection of colors of your choosing of Tsukineko inks in small bottles (for sale in classroom or bring your own)
- Fantastix painting applicators by Tsukineko (for sale in classroom or bring your own)
- Paper towels (just a few)
- If you already own fabric markers, bring them if you'd like to use
- An empty 1 gallon Ziploc for safely transporting supplies home

## **Optional:**

- --- Of the size you wish to paint...Bring A Basic line drawing (coloring book simplicity) of an item you would like to paint. You might want to keep this first project manageable in size... i.e. around 20" x 20" or smaller.
- --- I have several choices of ready to go drawings available so create your own only if you want.
- ---Full line of inks, Fantastix applicators, fabric and markers available for sale in classroom.
