MARCH 1, 1989

- The phone call committee should remind members to bring the 6-inch squares of fabric that Pauline Trout has requested to help illustrate her lecture, "Color"; these will be raffled off after Pauline has finished with them.
- We will take Pauline to dinner at the Beachside; Zetta will make the reservations. We should meet at 5:00.
- Pauline's workshop details: Colby will give Zetta a check and Zetta will give it to Pauline on Thursday; we'll give her a guild pin with the check. The workshop will run from 9:00 to 3:30; people should bring their own lunch. Zetta will bring Pauline's lunch. For workshop munchies, Jan will bring cookies, Marty will bring fruit, and Zetta will bring coffeecake and coffee. We should remind those taking the workshop that they'll need a zig-zag machine.
- In April, Judy Mathieson will give her lecture, "Creative Problem-Solving". She'll spend the night at Jan's house; we'll discuss other details at the April board meeting.

- Jan told us of the Judy Chicago exhibit at the UCSB Women's Center; this should be announced to the guild. Also, at Ventura College is a showing of quilts by Leslie Carabas; dates are February 28 to March 31, but times are erratic; if people want to go see this, they should call the college to be sure that they're open.
- Jan also mentioned that Camarillo's guild has asked our guild to be their guests for their Christmas in July meeting. Since vacations and kids out of school make it hard for people to plan for this type of thing, Jan will ask for a show of hands at the meeting to see if it's even worth it for Camarillo to plan on our being there.
- At the next meeting, Jan will mention Visions and urge people to become involved.
- Betty Cavallucci of Night Owl Quilters is building a house in Santa Barbara; she will bring her groups' Ugly Fabric Challenge quilts for our May program.
