In the absence of the recording secretary, Suzy Carter substituted for Gail Tinsley. The treasurer's report was submitted by Sandi Globus.

1. The next meeting of Coastal Quilter's/^{April 10} will be a joint one with members of the Natural History Museum and their Volunteer Committee at the Fleishman Auditorium at the Museum, at 7:30. The program features Barbara Hammersley, a historical speaker complete with early costumes, quilts, etc. She will appear first followed by the business meeting after the refreshment break. Four quilt racks will be needed - Zetta's, Carol (2) and Marty's. There was discussion of whether to use the Museum PA system or Coastal Quilter's which was not in operation at the close of the last meeting. We will have the regular block of the month - perhaps before the meeting or break time.

 Although April 15 is deadline for submission of both auction and nature challenge quilts, meeting night will be a convenient time to turn in auction quilts with entry forms to Sandi Globus or Judy Gorrindo; nature challenge to Sharon Doyle.
3. Natural Impressions show
 Sandi will make announcement about auction quilts for show at next meeting, as well as make a plea for all members to participate in some way. There will be a table for obtaining new members, selling tickets both for admission as well as for the opportunity to win the bird quilt, etc. Although there will be NO vendors, Christina Taylor Godwin, shop manager will have many items pertaining to quilts, including note paper with our handsome nature quilt picture. Also books will be available in her store. Rosalind Perry will be autographing her book.
Program advertising
 Susan Grzeskowiak has been gathering advertising at a rate of \$140 full page, \$75 ½ page, and \$40 ¼ page. The advertising is of a general nature, not specifically for quilters. It was suggested that Williams Bros. market which sells both hard to find freezer paper, and 2 gallon zip lock bags, and Russ' Camera should be good prospects.
