Community Quilts: Yolanda reported the quilts for Fostering Kids will be dispersed in June and quilts for Hospice will be dispersed in July. It was discussed if the quilts for Hospice should be kept in order for them to be displayed to advertise the Quilt Show. There was also a discussion on dispersing the quilts earlier in the future. Yolanda and Louisa have collected over 80 quilts and storing them has been a problem. No decision has been made for future charities.

Opportunity Quilt Ticket Sales: Sue Davies reported \$419 has been taken in for ticket sales. The appraiser for the quilt has not responded so Sue is looked for a local person to appraise the quilt. Quilt needs to insured since it will be traveling with Norah for shows. Sue had questions about postcards to help sell the tickets and was referred to Rosana Swing, Quilt Show PR chair.

Public Relations: Kathy reported there was a good turn out for the first Thursday event. Kathy also reported Grant House is also doing the pillow case challenge at his shop.

Programs: Dee reported Susy Pelovsky will be the Programs chair for the coming term. Dee also reported the Freddy Moran workshop was fun although the directions were unclear at times. May is Art Quilters month and Jake Finch will be the speaker in July. Beth Hawkins will be the speaker in August.

Workshop: Patty reported the Freddy Moran workshop was great. The June workshop with Jake Finch will be on a Saturday.

Corresponding Secretary: Barbara reported Julie Mock will be the corresponding secretary for the next term.
