Bee Saunders, President - Overview and announcements

Sandra O'Meara, Treasurer

- Treasurer's reports Balance Sheet and Income and Expense MSC Butterfield/Frangos
- Proposed budget for 2022-23 MSC O'Meara/Butterfield
- Will start in May to create the budget for next year
- No final numbers for Quilt Show Boutique income yet, but it's close to the original estimate
- Will get a \$2,000 refund from Earl Warren Showgrounds
- Quilt Show costs were higher than last time, but we still made a profit of about \$4,200
- Recommendation by Nancy Butterfield: get advertisers and sponsors for the next Quilt Show
- Recommendation by Rochelle Schneider: raise price of tickets
- Sandy would like to enroll CQG in TechSoup. TechSoup is a nonprofit organization that facilitates the exchanges of resources (such as accounting software) between donor companies (such as Intuit QuickBooks) and nonprofit organizations (such as CQG). The primary purpose for this is to be able to request an upgraded version of QuickBooks for the annual administrative fee of \$75. Currently we are using the lowest Essentials version of Quickbooks costing \$320/year which has many limitations such as no budget feature, etc. Through TechSoup we will be able to receive the Plus version of QuickBooks Online with more advanced features and an annual cost of \$75. So we will have improved usage and less cost.
