COMMUNITY QUILTS: Carol Barringer

There are now 53 quilts completed for the Veteran's project. The goal is to complete 75 by the day after Veteran's Day, November 12, 2015. Carol asked for volunteers to quilt several quilt tops which have been sewn. Members at the meeting did volunteer to quilt these quilts. The last workshop to sew Veteran's quilts is October 17. Carol asked that members sign up for this workshop so that she will know how many to expect.

The next Community quilt project will be to make quilts and Christmas stockings for CALM organization. (Child Abuse, Listening, and Mediation)

They have asked for 100 Christmas stockings which should be turned in at the November meeting. Kits were distributed to members. Carol showed examples of stockings and states that she has many scraps available to anyone who needs them. They also need 100 quilts. This quilt project will start in January, 2016.
