## Children's Delight

Finished quilt size: 43" x 54"
Finished block size: 9"
Finished sashing width: 2"
Finished border width: 4"
Fabrics needed:
2 yards for block centers and borders.
1/2 yard for block rectangles.
$1 / 4$ yard for block squares.
1 yard for sashing.
1/4 yard for posts.
2 yards (with some piecing) for backing.
$1 / 2$ yard for binding.


## Children's Delight

Instructions

## Cutting:

Block centers and borders:
Cut 2 yards down the fold.
From one piece, cut 4 ( $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ yards) borders.
From second piece, fussy cut 12 (5-1/2") squares.
Block rectangles:
Cut 48 (2-1/2" x 5-1/2") rectangles.
Block small squares:
Cut 48 (2-1/2") squares.
Sashing:
Cut 31 (2-1/2" x 9-1/2") rectangles.
Posts:
Cut $20\left(2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ squares.

## Assembly:

1. Referring to piecing diagram below, arrange block centers, rectangles and small squares. Piece 12 blocks, pressing seams to rectangles.
Block should measure 9-1/2".

2. Referring to quilt diagram, arrange blocks, sashing rectangles and posts.

Sew into rows. Press seams toward sashing.
Sew rows together.

3. Add borders.
