## Framers

Finished quilt size: $44^{\prime \prime}$ x 52"
Finished block size: 8"
Finished border width: 1" and 5"

## Fabrics needed:

1 yard of large children's print for block centers.
1 yard of two different fabrics for frames.
Use one of these fabrics also for border cornerstones.
$1 / 2$ yard for inner borders.
1-3/4 yards for outer borders.
2 yards (with some piecing) for backing.
$1 / 2$ yard for binding.


## Framers

Instructions

## Cutting:

Block centers:
Fussy cut twenty 5-1/2" squares. Squares may also be randomly cut.
Frame fabrics:
Frame fabric \#1: Cut $20\left(2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ rectangles and $20\left(2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ rectangles.
Frame fabric \#2: Cut 20 ( $2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) rectangles and 20 ( $2^{\prime \prime} \times 8$ 8-1/2") rectangles. Cut 4 cornerstones 5-1/2" square.
Inner borders:
Cut the following strips cross grain.
Cut 6 strips $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} x$ width of the fabric. Piece to make 4 borders strips.
Outer borders:
Cut the following strips along the lengthwise grain.
Cut 4 borders 5-1/2" x 1-3/4 yds.

## Assembly:

In Block A the short strips are at the sides of the center and the long strips are at the top and bottom. In Block B the short strips are at the top and bottom and the long strips are at the sides of the center. Piecing Blocks A and B in this manner will make assembly very easy, with no seams to match.


## 1. Block A:

Sew $2\left(2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strips to the sides of the center square.
Sew $2\left(2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strips to the top and bottom of the center square.
Make 10 A blocks. Blocks should measure 8-1/2".
2. Block B:

Sew $2\left(2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strips to the top and bottom of the center square.
Sew $2\left(2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strips to the sides of the center square.
Make 10 B blocks. Blocks should measure 8-1/2".
3. Referring to the quilt diagram, layout blocks to form the quilt.

Sew blocks into rows. Press seams in alternating directions.
Sew rows together. Press seams in alternating directions.
4. Add inner borders.
5. Add short outer borders.

Sew cornerstones to long outer borders. Press to borders.
Add long border unit.
