Quilted Christmas Stocking

Finished size: 9-1/2" x 18-1/2"

Fabrics needed: 2/3 yard each of: Christmas fabric, muslin*, lining fabric and batting.

*Muslin or any solid or any print. *It will be inside and will not show.*

Template::

Tape 3 stocking template pieces together, matching the dotted lines. *Template includes 1/2" seam allowance.*

Cutting: Cut one front and one back each from: Christmas fabric Muslin Lining fabric Batting.

Assembly:

Pattern allows for 1/2" seam allowance.

- Layer front, batting and muslin. Baste. Layer back, batting and muslin. Baste. Quilt as desired.
- 2. Pin a loop of ribbon on the side of stocking front, about 1" from top of front, with loop facing in and raw edges even with raw edges of front. Baste in place.
 With right sides together, stitch the stocking front and back together, leaving the top open.
 Trim and clip as needed. Turn to the right side.
- 3. With right sides together, stitch the lining front and back together, leaving a 6" opening on the side for turning and leaving the top open. Trim and clip as needed. Do not turn.
- 4. Insert the stocking front/back unit down into the stitched lining pieces. The stocking and lining will have right sides together. Match side seams. Pin. Sew around the top of the stocking.
- 5. Reach in through the side opening of the lining and pull stocking through the opening. Turn the lining to the right side.
- 6. Stitch opening in the lining closed. *You can do this by machine it won't show.*Stuff the lining down inside the stocking, leaving 1/2" of lining showing on the outside. Stitch in the ditch to secure.
