Block size: 6"


## Fabrics needed:

Light: $\quad 1 / 2$ yard for 4-patch units
Medium: $\quad 1 / 2$ yard for 4 -patch units
Plain squares: $2 / 3$ yard
Borders: $1-1 / 2$ yards
Backing: 1-1/2 yards
Binding: $1 / 2$ yard
Cutting:
Light:
4 (3-1/2" x width of fabric) strips.
Medium: $\quad 4\left(3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}\right.$ width of fabric) strips.
Plain squares: $3\left(6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}\right.$ width of fabric) strips.
Cut into 17 (6-1/2") squares.
Borders: Cut borders along the lengthwise grain. 4 (4-1/2" $\times 1-1 / 2$ yards)

## Assembly:

1. Sew light and medium 3-1/2" strips together. Make 4 strip sets. Cut into 36 (3-1/2") units.
2. Sew units together to make 18 (4-patch) units.

3. Arrange 4-patch units and plain squares to make quilt. Sew into rows. Sew rows together.
4. Add borders.
