

Fabrics needed:
2/3 yds. of light for nine patch blocks
2/3 yd. of medium for nine patch blocks
2/3 yd. for plain squares
1-1/2 yds. for borders
1-1/2 yds. for backing
1/2 yd. for binding

## Cutting:

Light for nine patch blocks:
7 (2-1/2" x width of fabric) strips.
Medium for nine patch blocks:
8 (2-1/2" x width of fabric) strips.
Plain squares:
3 (6-1/2" x width of fabric) strips.
Cut into 17 (6-1/2") squares.
Borders:
Cut borders along the lengthwise grain. 4 ( $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1-1 / 2$ yards)

## Assembly:

1. Sew strips into two different strips sets.

Strip set \# 1 includes 2 medium and 1 light. Make 3 sets.
Strip set \#2 includes 1 medium and 2 light. Make 2 sets.
Press seams to medium.
2. Cut strips sets into $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ units. Join units to make 18 nine-patch blocks.

3. Arrange nine-patch blocks with plain squares to make quilt. Sew into rows. Sew rows together.
4. Add borders.
