Pinwheels
Quilt size: 38" x 50"
Block size: $6^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabrics needed:

2/3 yard of light for pinwheel blocks
2/3 yard of medium for pinwheel blocks
$2 / 3$ yard for plain squares
1-1/2 yard for borders
1-1/2 yard for backing
1/2 yards for binding

## Cutting:

Light for pinwheel blocks: 36 (4-1/4") squares

Medium for pinwheel blocks: 36 (4-1/4") squares

Plain squares:
17 (6-1/2") squares
Borders: Cut borders along the lengthwise grain. 4 ( $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1-1 / 2$ yards)

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## Assembly:

Draw a line $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from each side of the cutting line. These are the sewing lines.
With right sides together, stitch light squares to medium squares, stitching on each sewing lines. Cut on cutting line. Press units to the medium triangle. Trim units to 3-1/2".

2. Piece 4 triangle units together to make the Pinwheel block. Block should measure 6-1/2". Make 18 blocks.

3. Arrange Pinwheel blocks and plain squares to make the quilt.
4. Sew into rows. Sew rows together.
5. Add borders.
