Two Step A very easy version of the Log Cabin Courthouse Steps pattern. Quilt size: 38" x 45-1/2" Block size: 7-1/2"

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Fabrics needed:

1-1/2 yard of a focus print for blocks and borders 2/3 yard of light for blocks 2/3 yard of medium for blocks 1-1/2 yards for backing

1/2 yards for binding

## Cutting:

Focus print Cut borders along the lengthwise grain. 4 borders (4-1/2" x 1-1/2 yards) 40 (2") squares 40 (2" x 5") rectangles


## Light:

10 (2") squares 20 (2" x 5") rectangles 20 (2" x 8") rectangles

Medium: 10 (2") squares 20 (2" x 5") rectangles 20 (2" x 8") rectangles


## Assembly:

1. Piece 10 Block A and 10 Block B, as shown. Block should measure 8".



			Make 10 Block B
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2. Arrange A and B blocks to make the quilt. For ease of construction, turn B blocks 90 degrees.



3. Sew into rows. Sew rows together.

4. Add borders.
