Block size: 12"
Borders finished widths: $1^{\prime \prime}$ and 4"


## Fabrics needed:

Blocks can be made with various prints or just 1 print each: red, white, blue.

Block fabrics:
1 yard
or
36 (4-1/2" $\left.\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ light rectangles $\frac{1}{2}$ yard
or
18 (4-1/2" $\left.\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ red rectangles $\frac{1}{2}$ yard
or
18 (4-1/2" $\left.\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ red rectangles
$\frac{1}{2}$ yard for inner border
1 yard for outer border
$\frac{1}{2}$ yard for binding

## Cutting:

Inner borders: 6 (1-1/2" $\times$ width of fabric) strips
Outer borders: 6 (4-1/2" $\times$ width of fabric) strips
Binding: 6 (2-1/2" $\times$ width of fabric) strips

## Assembly:

1. Piece blue and light rectangles to make 6 (12-1/2") rectangles blocks.

2. Press to blue.
3. Piece red and light rectangles to make $6\left(12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ rectangles blocks.
4. Press to red.
5. Referring to the diagram, sew blocks into rows.
6. Sew rows together.
7. Add inner and outer borders.
