
Patriotic Tam's Patch Lap Quilt

Quilt size: 46" x 58"

Block size: 12"

Borders finished widths: 1" and 4"



Fabrics needed:

Block fabrics:

1/3 yard of red print for blocks $\frac{3}{4}$ yard of blue print for blocks

Veterans Quilt Project

 $\frac{3}{4}$ yard of patriotic print for blocks

 $\frac{1}{2}$ yard for inner border

1 yard for outer border

 $\frac{1}{2}$ yard for binding

Cutting:

Red: 24 (3-1/2") squares

Blue: 24 (3-1/2") squares and 24 $(3-1/2" \times 6-1/2")$ rectangles

Patriotic print: 24 (6-1/2") squares

Inner borders: 6 (1-1/2" \times width of fabric) strips Outer borders: 6 (4-1/2" \times width of fabric) strips

Binding: 6 (2-1/2" x width of fabric) strips

Assembly:

- 1. Piece 24 blocks units from red and blue prints. Press to blue.
- 2. Piece units with plain blocks to make 12 Tam's Patch blocks.
- 3. Referring to the diagram, sew blocks into rows.
- 4. Sew rows together.
- 5. Add inner and outer borders.
