

Our speaker VICKI L. JOHNSON is a quilter and college teacher from northern California. Her current emphasis in on quilts which use the California coast as inspriation and has integrated painted and pieced fabric surfaces. She will show slides of her quilts in which she uses her personal landscape environment as inspiration. In a series of steps, the development of one quilt will be shown so you can see how the painting builds and the piecing and applique are integrated.

Presentation of quilts made by members who choose to participate in the nature themed challange. Participants have been working on these quilts since the beginning of the year and this will be the first viewing. Mrs. Webster was a quilt designer, maker, entrepreneur, researcher and author during the 20th century. Her book, QUILTS, THEIR STORY AND HOW TO MAKE THEM, has long been out of print, but recently Rosalind undertook the job of republishing the book with new updates. Rosalind will share stories about her famous grandmother as well as show some of her quilts. PLUS we will have the first opportunity to purchase the new book "hot-off-the-press".

FROM NORTH: HIGHWAY 101, exit FAIRVIEW AVE, turn left, curve around over freeway, turn left at signal to stay on Fairview. Proceed 4 blocks. Library is on the right.

GENERAL RESEARCH CORPORATION:

FROM SOUTH: HIGHWAY 101, exit WARD MEMORIAL FREEWAY, curve over freeway, exit HOLLISTER AVE. Turn left, proceed several blocks, turn right into GENERAL RESEARCH driveway. Entrance to building is on the left side of building.

FROM NORTH: HIGHWAY 101, exit PATTERSON AVE, turn right, proceed thru signal at Hollister Ave. Pass hospital, emergency entrance and parking. Turn right on first street after the General Research sign.
