 - Quilt entries must consist of three layers: top, batting, backing
- Construction and quilting may be done by hand or by machine
- Quilt projects must be pieced by the participant but may be quilted by nonyouth.
 - Any assistance received with quilt entry should be detailed and noted on the entry form.
- Decorative items such as pillows, pillow covers, table runners and placemats are acceptable entries, but must be guilted and consist of 3 layers.
- Quilters may use any type of embellishment, batting and backing.
- Quilts larger than 24" square must have a 4" deep rod pocket at top-back edge of quilt. This will be used to hang the quilt at the show.
- The Quilt must have a label includes the title and your name located on the back of the quilt, lower right corner.
- One quilt entry per participant, including group entries.
